

This research focuses on the governance of urban and territorial transformations during a time of significant redefinition of tools, methods, and techniques for spatial planning and design. Key research areas include: i) analysis, planning, and design of interventions for the environment, landscape, built environment, and settlement morphologies; ii) integrating urban and territorial planning with climate change mitigation and adaptation measures, and risk reduction; iii) developing methods, tools, and practices for sustainable and resilient recovery, rehabilitation, and regeneration of cities and territories; iv) advancing theories, methods, and tools for designing healthy, livable, and risk-resilient urban environments.


